What we do:

CEO provides equal access to K-8th accredited private schools awarding one-half tuition up to a maximum of \$2,100/year. Parents are responsible for the balance of the tuition.



How to qualify for scholarships:

Parents qualify if their income level is at or within 200% of the Federal Poverty Income Level for the size of their families. Residents of Bridgeport, East Hartford, Hartford, New Haven, and Waterbury Connecticut may apply. However, CEO continues to explore opportunities to expand the number of Connecticut areas and families to serve.

Families seek out CEO because they want a better life for their children and believe investing in a private school education will help their children reach their full potential.
